Short statement giving reasons for wishing to participate in FoES Board and skills and expertise that the candidate will bring:

FOES's strong focus on climate justice is what attracted me to apply for a Board position. I am a Senior Lecturer in Marketing at the University of Stirling (since 2018), having previously worked for Durham University, The University of Nottingham, and The University of Nottingham Ningbo China. My research interests are eclectic, including politics, religion and consumption; identity questions (organisational, ethnic/racial, religious or political); immigration; and (religious) tourism.
