- Work with the Head of Operations and the staff team to ensure the proper management of the charity's funds, assets and financial affairs.

- Strong grasp of accounting principles, and the ways of working in a small Charity budgeting, and financial management.
- Good independent judgment and ability to explain finances to non-experts.
