Since moving to Scotland in 2019 I have been an active member of the climate justice movement, organising and participating in direct action against the fossil fuel industry from Grangemouth to Aberdeen. During a period of strict bail conditions that followed the attempted occupation of an oil rig, myself and many of the other people involved in that action turned our energy away from direct action against the fossil fuel industry and started a community mushroom farm, a space where we could grow food for our community, build resilience to climate change and open dialogue in our communities about the radical change we need to see in society.

I hope that my time on the front line of climate activism in Scotland can help bring useful strategic insight to the FOEs board, and that my experience (collectively) managing a successful worker's cooperative for the last six years has equipped me with useful facilitation and administrative skills relevant to the role of trustee.

I greatly admire the research and campaigning that FOEs carries out and it would be a privilege to try contribute to the growth and success of its strategy in coming years.
